The Pastors Pen

Dear Campbell Chapel,

March and April are very special months on the liturgical calendar. March 1st is Fat Tuesday. Fat Tuesday is also known as Shrove Tuesday, Mardi Gras, Carnival, and International Pancake Day. All of these observances grew out of the same tradition. The early Church prepared for the 40 days of Lent by removing lard from their homes. Many would bake small confession cakes or Shrove Cakes. These cakes served two purposes. First, they provided a means for eliminating lard from the homes. Second, they allow the believer to prepare his or her heart for Lent. Mardi Gras and Carnival are extreme celebrations in preparation of Lent. The overindulging of these festivals radically ends at midnight, just in time to usher in Lent.

Ash Wednesday is March 2nd. Ash Wednesday is the beginning of Lent. It is in radical contrast to Fat Tuesday. Ash Wednesday begins a 40 day fast. The Beaufort District will hold an Ash Wednesday Service for all of the churches of the Beaufort District (TBA). At this service, ashes will be imposed on the foreheads of the worshippers. The minister will pronounce the warning, "Remember that thou art dust and to dust thou shall return." The ashes for Ash Wednesday are produced by burning the Palm Branches from the previous Palm Sunday. This practice emphasizes the fact that we are all sinners.

At Campbell Chapel, we will observe Lent with a daily Prayer and Scripture Service. Each morning of Lent at 6:00 a.m., we will meet on Zoom for approximately 10 minutes. The Prayer and Scripture Services will be conducted every day except Sundays. (The 40 Days of Lent do not include the Sundays.)

Holy Week is April 10th - 16th. Holy Week is the last week of Lent. Sunday, April 10th is Palm Sunday. It is the Sunday we celebrate Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem. At Campbell Chapel, Brother Lincoln Kannick will decorate our sanctuary with Palm Branches. The worshippers will wear small crosses made of Palms. Members are encouraged to keep the palms for next year's Ash Wednesday Service.

April 14th is Maundy Thursday. Maundy Thursday marks the day Jesus celebrated the Last Supper with his disciples. It is also the day that some congregations hold Foot Washing Services. Both practices are based on John chapter 13. Campbell Chapel will not hold a public service on Maundy Thursday.

April 15th is Good Friday. Good Friday observes Jesus' death and Passion on the Cross. At Campbell Chapel, we will hold a Seventh Last Word Service. At that service, seven short sermons will be preached. Each sermon will focus on one of Jesus' statements from the cross.

April 17th is Easter. On Easter Campbell Chapel holds a Sunrise Service and the 10:00 a.m. Service. Holy Communion is served at both Services. Between the two services, the Children participate in a Children's Easter Program.

March and April are very important months of fasting, celebrations, and worship. Please cover these events with your prayers.
